Mandatory Coaches Meeting at 8:30 am on Court 2. 1st match warmup will begin at 8:40 am - Please be prompt!

The first match will go off at 9am with a 20 minute (5,6,6,3) warmup for the first match of the day for each team. Each subsequent match will be started by a 10 minute warmup (4,4,2). Each warmup will begin immediately upon conclusion of the prior match. Each match will be played best 2/3 sets, with the first two sets played to 25 with no cap and a 3rd set (if necessary) to 15 - no cap. The higher seed listed on the schedule shall assume the role of "home" team.

All teams are guaranteed 3 pool play matches with single elimination playoff. Minimum 4 matches.

Spectator/Participant Guidelines

Please be aware that AHS student athletes will be refereeing during pool play, silver and bronze bracket playoffs - we ask that you do your best in respecting these individuals who are volunteering their time so this tournament can be put on. Any person making derogatory or defamatory statements toward a student athlete while reffing or scorekeeping will be asked to leave immediately!

The Tournament Director shall have final word on any decision that arises during the matches. Participants should "nest" their bags and belongings at tables on the balcony level only. Admission will be \$5 for Adults and \$3 for students. Full concessions will be available throughout the day featuring Jet's Pizza and other various concession standbys. Please keep outside food to a minimum and please pick up whatever trash you generate throught the day! Please do not bring anything other than water onto the courts.

One line judge needs to be provided by your team for ANY pool play match in which you are NOT competing in.

Playoff Brackets

he winners of all 3 pools shall advance to the Gold bracket. Winners will be declared by match record - if a tie exists then ties will be broken by:

- 1) Head to Head
- 2) Game %
- 3) Point %
- 4) Coin toss

The highest ranked 2nd place team from ANY pool will advance to the Gold bracket as the "wild Card" team. Use this formula to determine highest ranked 2nd place team.

- 1) Match record
- 2) Game %
- 3) Point %
- 4) Coin toss

The remaining 2nd place finishers and the highest two ranked 3rd place teams (see above formula) shall advance to the Silver Bracket. Silver Bracket will be seeded by pool play finish. Silver Bracket playoffs will be one match to determine final finish.

The remaining 3rd place finisher and all 4th place finishers shall compete in the Bronze Bracket. Bronze Bracket will be seeded by pool play finish. Bronze Bracket playoffs will be one match to determine final finish.
