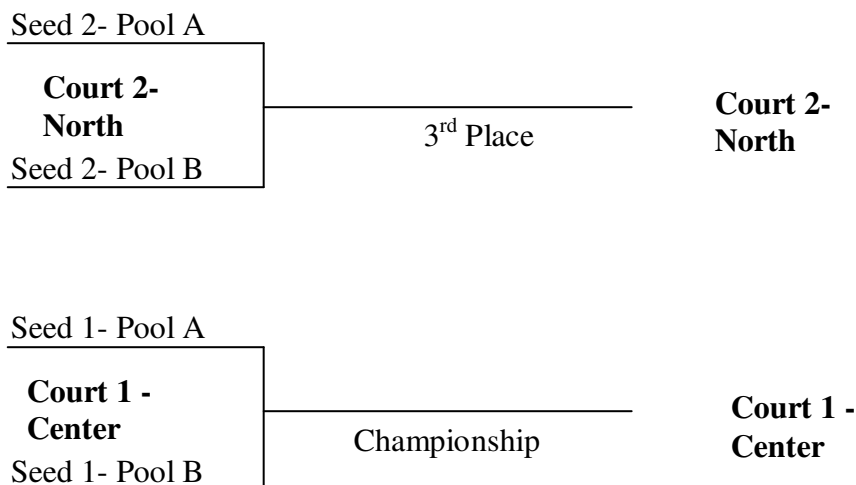

Site: Mound Westonka High School

Start: 9:00 a.m. pool play begins, doors open at 8:00 a.m.

Admission: \$ 6 Adults; \$ 4 Students and Senior Citizens (No passes honored).

Concessions: A healthy variety available throughout tournament. **No coolers or boxes of food allowed.** Please no food or beverages (other than water) in the gym.

Locker Rooms: Available to share, players are responsible for their own valuables.

Trainer: A certified trainer will be on duty throughout the day.

Line Judges: Each team must **supply one line judge for each match** they play, including playoffs. Also, if using a **libero**, you must be able to provide a tracker if necessary, including play-offs. Registered officials will work each match.

Warmups: Match 1 & 2 will have a 15 minute warm-up (5 minutes shared, 4 minutes hitting, 2 minutes serving). All other matches will have an 10 minute warm-up (2 minutes shared, 3 minutes hitting, 2 minutes serving). All matches will start 10 minutes following the completion of the previous match, please make sure your team is ready.

Tournament rules:

- Two pools: Four teams in each pool, each team guaranteed 3 matches..
- Pool play: Each match is best 2 out of 3 games to 25 points using rally scoring, no cap. Team must win by 2 points. If third game is necessary, it will be rally score to 15 points, no cap.
- In case of tie in pool play, place will be determined by:
 - Matches won
 - Head to head competition
 - Least games lost
 - Point differential between any teams that tie
- Playoffs: Same scoring as pool play.

Trophies/Awards: Trophy and medals to Champions; Medals to 2nd and 3rd place finishers.

Parking: All buses and fans are asked to unload and enter through the north doors (Lower parking lot).
